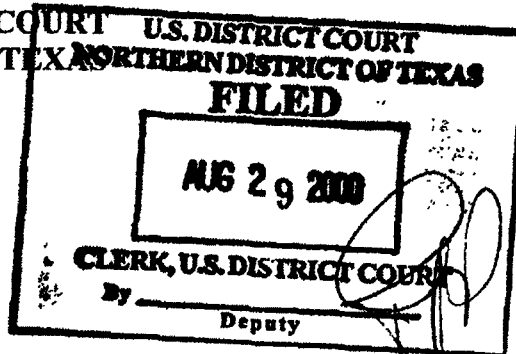

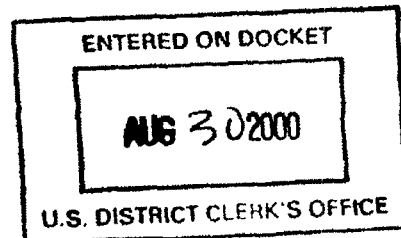

**ORDER AMENDING ORDER APPROVING RECEIVER'S FINAL REPORT

On the 25th day of August, 2000, the Court considered the Receiver's Final Report and Proposed Distribution. Thereafter, the Court entered its Order of August 25, 2000 Approving Receiver's Final Report and Proposed Distribution. In connection with making the distributions approved by virtue of the Order however, the Receiver discovered and has advised the Court of four errors in the Exhibit "A" to the Court's August 25, 2000 Order. The Receiver has requested that the Court issue an Order amending its August 25, 2000 Order to correct these errors and thereby increase the distribution amount to all other holders of allowed investor claims. The Court believes that such an amended Order is appropriate. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the Court's Order of August 25, 2000 Approving Receiver's Final Report and Proposed Distribution is amended as to Exhibit "A." The prior Exhibit "A" is hereby superceded and replaced with the Exhibit "A" attached to this Order. The Receiver is hereby authorized to make distribution payments to each person and entity in the amount set forth in Exhibit "A" to this Order. All other provisions of the Court's August 25, 2000 Order shall remain in full force and effect.
