

company, by 4:30 p.m. on August 4, 2000. The Receiver shall file his motion to abandon by 4:30 p.m. on August 14, 2000.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Receiver shall make available to the credit card companies for inspection by August 7, 2000, at a mutually convenient time and in the Receiver's offices, the back-up documentation relating to his objections to the investor's claims. The Receiver is under no burden to assemble, extract or collate such documentation, but shall provide the credit card companies access to such documents as kept in the normal course of business by the Receiver.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Receiver's anticipated applications for fees and final distribution plan, currently set for July 28, 2000, is reset for August 25, 2000 at 10:00 a.m. The Receiver shall file his fee applications and final distribution plan no later than 4:30 p.m. on August 23, 2000.
