The Receiver shall also provide the Court with a good faith estimate of the amount of money he realistically expects to recover on behalf of the defrauded investors as a direct result of this lawsuit. The Court may revoke its prior order appointing Michael J. Quilling as Receiver in this case if a budget is not submitted within the time specified herein.

A hearing is set for August 24, 2000 at 9:00 a.m. in the courtroom of Magistrate Judge Jeff Kaplan, 1100 Commerce Street, 16th Floor, Dallas, Texas. The Receiver is ordered to attend this hearing. Defendants and all interested parties may present their objections to the proposed budget at that time. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Court will tentatively approve or disapprove the budget and establish procedures for payment of the Receiver.

The Receiver is ordered to serve defendants and all interested parties with a copy of his proposed litigation budget.
