Written objections to the proposed allocation and payment must be filed by <u>April 6, 2001</u>. Defendants and interested parties will be given an opportunity to present their objections to the motion at the hearing.

¹ By separate order this date, the Court authorized the Receiver to designate four receivership estates for purposes of handling claims and making distributions to defrauded investors. The four estates are: (1) Cord/Winterhawk; (2) Funding Resource Group; (3) Howe Financial Trust; and (4) Hammersmith Trust. See ORDER, 3/12/01.
