AGREED FINAL JUDGMENT AGAINST MARY ANN BAUCE

Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission"), having filed its Complaint in this matter, together with amendments thereto, and Relief Defendant Mary Ann Bauce ("Bauce"), through her Stipulation and Consent ("Consent"), having admitted service of the Summons and of the Complaint, together with amendments thereto, having admitted the jurisdiction of this Court over her and over the subject matter of this action, having waived the entry of findings of fact and conclusions of law pursuant to Rule 52 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, having entered into her Consent voluntarily, no threats, promises of immunity or assurances having been made by the Commission or by any of its members, officers, agents, attorneys or other representatives to induce Bauce to enter into the Consent, having consented, without admitting or denying any of the allegations in the Commission's Complaint and amendments thereto, except as to jurisdiction as set

forth above, to entry without further notice of this Final Judgment Against Mary Ann Bauce ("Final Judgment") requiring Bauce to make disgorgement; it further appearing that this Court has jurisdiction over Bauce and the subject matter of this action and that no further notice of hearing for the entry of this Final Judgment need be given; and the Court being fully advised in the premises:

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Bauce shall make full disgorgement, *i.e.*, \$77,376.88, to Michael J. Quilling, Esq. ("Quilling"), Quilling, Selander, Cummiskey & Lownds, PC, 1800 Bryan Tower, 2001 Bryan Street, Dallas, Texas 75201-3730, Telephone: 214/871-2100, Facsimile: 214/871-2111, as temporary receiver. When Bauce makes payment of \$77,376.88, she shall do so in currency, by wire transfer or in the form of certified funds delivered to Quilling, as temporary receiver, she shall provide a copy of the check or other instrument used to make payment to Robert A. Brunig, Senior Trial Counsel, Securities and Exchange Commission, Fort Worth District Office, 801 Cherry Street, Suite 1900, Fort Worth, TX 76102-6819.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Consent filed herein be, and the same is hereby, incorporated in this Final Judgment with the same force and effect as if fully set forth herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction of this action for all purposes, including for purposes of entertaining any suitable application or motion.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED That this Final Judgment may be served upon Bauce in person or by mail either by the United States marshal, by the Clerk of the Court or by any member of the staff of the Commission.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED That, based on an express determination that there is no just reason for delay, the Clerk of Court shall enter judgment accordingly.
