

## ORDER SETTING HEARING

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for the Hammersmith Trust Estate, has filed a motion to determine responsibility for filing tax returns. The Receiver maintains that given the limited assets of the Estate, he should not be burdened with the cost and responsibility of preparing tax returns for the Hammersmith Trust or the individual subjects of the receivership.

A hearing on the motion is set for <u>April 23, 2004</u> at <u>9:00 a.m.</u> before U.S. Magistrate Judge Jeff Kaplan, 1100 Commerce Street, 16th Floor, Dallas, Texas. Written objections to the motion must be filed by <u>April 13, 2004</u>. The Internal Revenue Service and all interested parties will be given an opportunity to present their objections at the hearing.

The Receiver is ordered to serve a copy of his motion and this order on a representative of the Internal Revenue Service.
