ORDER SETTING HEARING

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Funding Resource Group and related entities, has filed an application for \$705.00 in attorney's fees and \$1.60 in expenses for services performed and costs incurred in prosecuting a claim against David Johnson in the United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee. *Granite Holdings, et al. v. Johnson*, No. 00-2098-G/V. The Receiver also seeks authority to pay his local counsel, Borod & Kramer, \$2,596.00 in attorney's fees. The application covers legal fees and expenses incurred in the *Johnson* litigation from December 1, 2001 through February 28, 2002 as to the Receiver, and from November 1, 2001 through January 31, 2002 as to Borod & Kramer.

A hearing on the application for fees and expenses is set for <u>April 19, 2002</u> at <u>10:00 a.m.</u> in the courtroom of Magistrate Judge Jeff Kaplan, 1100 Commerce Street, 16th Floor, Dallas, Texas. Written objections to the application must be filed by <u>April 9, 2002</u>. Defendants and interested parties will be given an opportunity to present their objections to the application at the hearing.
