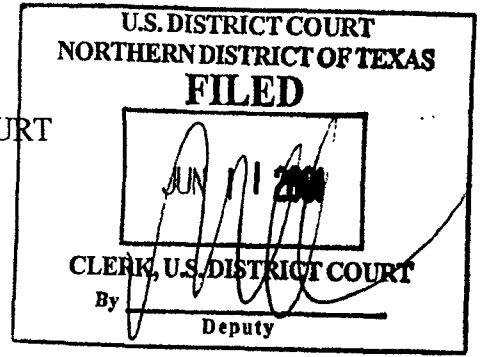

**ORDER SETTING HEARING**

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Funding Resource Group and related entities, has filed an application for \$3,175.00 in fees and \$50.06 in expenses for services performed and costs incurred in prosecuting a claim against David Johnson in the United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee. *Granite Holdings, et al. v. Johnson*, No. 00-2098-G/V. The Receiver also seeks authority to pay his local counsel, Borod & Kramer, \$2,755.00 in attorney's fees and \$824.81 in expenses.<sup>1</sup> The application covers legal services performed and expenses incurred in the *Johnson* litigation from December 1, 2000 through May 31, 2001.


A hearing on the fee application is set for **July 13, 2001** at **9:00 a.m.** in the courtroom of Magistrate Judge Jeff Kaplan, 1100 Commerce Street, 16th Floor, Dallas, Texas. Written objections to the application must be filed by **July 2, 2001**. Defendants and interested parties will be given an opportunity to present their objections to the application at the hearing.

<sup>1</sup> The application seeks attorney's fees for Borod & Kramer in the amount of \$2,785.00. However, the billing statements submitted by the law firm total \$2,755.00 in fees.
