ORDER SETTING HEARING

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Funding Resource Group and related entities, has filed an application for \$6,360.00 in fees and \$101.90 in expenses for services performed and costs incurred in prosecuting a claim against David Johnson in the United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee. *Granite Holdings, et al. v. Johnson*, No. 00-2098-G/V. The Receiver also seeks authority to pay his local counsel, Borod & Kramer, \$1,289.75 in attorney's fees and \$100.97 in expenses. The application covers legal services performed and expenses incurred in the *Johnson* litigation from June 1, 2001 through August 31, 2001 as to the Receiver, and from May 1, 2001 through July 31, 2001 as to Borod & Kramer.

A hearing on the fee application is set for <u>October 18, 2001</u> at <u>9:00 a.m.</u> in the courtroom of Magistrate Judge Jeff Kaplan, 1100 Commerce Street, 16th Floor, Dallas, Texas. Written objections to the application must be filed by <u>October 9, 2001</u>. Defendants and interested parties will be given an opportunity to present their objections to the application at the hearing.

The Receiver is ordered to post a copy of his application and this Order on his website, SECRECEIVER.COM. Appropriate links to the court's docket sheet shall also be provided on the website.
