

## ORDER SETTING HEARING

§

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Funding Resource Group and related entities, has filed an application for \$1,590.00 in attorney's fees and \$4.00 in expenses for services performed and costs incurred in prosecuting a claim against Mark Talley in the United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee. Quilling v. Talley, No. 00-3041-G/BRE. The Receiver also seeks authority to pay his local counsel, Borod & Kramer, \$10,989.10 in attorney's fees and \$517.40 in expenses. The application covers legal fees and expenses incurred in the Talley litigation from December 1, 2001 through February 28, 2002 as to the Receiver, and from November 1, 2001 through January 31, 2002 as to Borod & Kramer.

A hearing on the application for fees and expenses is set for April 19, 2002 at 10:00 a.m. in the courtroom of Magistrate Judge Jeff Kaplan, 1100 Commerce Street, 16th Floor, Dallas, Texas. Written objections to the application must be filed by April 9, 2002. Defendants and interested parties will be given an opportunity to present their objections to the application at the hearing.

The Receiver is ordered to post a copy of his application and this Order on his website, SECRECEIVER.COM. Appropriate links to the court's docket sheet shall also be provided on the website.
