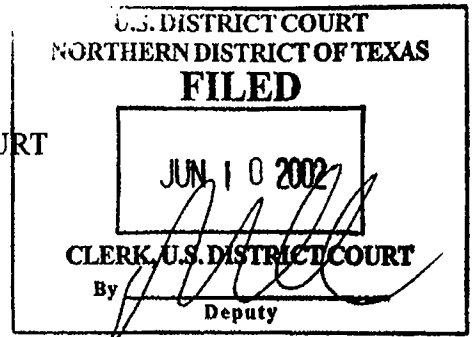

**ORDER SETTING HEARING**

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Funding Resource Group and related entities, has filed an application for \$1,451.00 in attorney's fees and \$87.31 in expenses for services performed and costs incurred in prosecuting a claim against Mark Talley in the United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee. *Quilling v. Talley*, No. 00-3041-G/BRE. The Receiver also seeks authority to pay his local counsel, Borod & Kramer, \$8,554.00 in attorney's fees and \$833.32 in expenses. The application covers legal fees and expenses incurred in the *Talley* litigation from March 1, 2002 through May 31, 2002 as to the Receiver, and from February 1, 2002 through April 30, 2002 as to Borod & Kramer.


A hearing on the fee application is set for **July 19, 2002** at **9:00 a.m.** in the courtroom of U.S. Magistrate Judge Jeff Kaplan, 1100 Commerce Street, 16th Floor, Dallas, Texas. Written objections to the application must be filed by **July 9, 2002**. Interested parties will be given an opportunity to present their objections to the application at the hearing.
