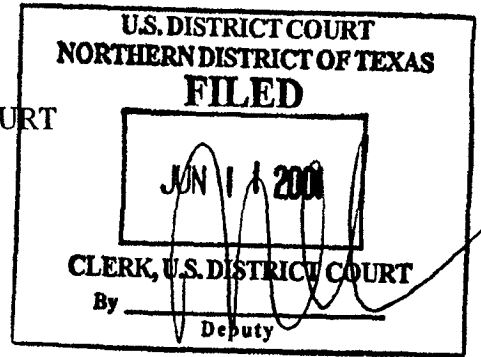

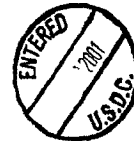

ORDER SETTING HEARING

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Funding Resource Group and related entities, has filed an application for \$3,370.00 in fees and \$15.07 in expenses for services performed and costs incurred in prosecuting a claim against Mark Talley in the United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee. *Quilling v. Talley*, No. 00-3041-G/BRE. The Receiver also seeks authority to pay his local counsel, Borod & Kramer, \$773.65 in attorney's fees and \$271.44 in expenses. The application covers legal services performed and expenses incurred in the *Talley* litigation from December 1, 2000 through May 31, 2001.

A hearing on the fee application is set for **July 13, 2001** at **9:00 a.m.** in the courtroom of Magistrate Judge Jeff Kaplan, 1100 Commerce Street, 16th Floor, Dallas, Texas. Written objections to the application must be filed by **July 2, 2001**. Defendants and interested parties will be given an opportunity to present their objections to the application at the hearing.


