ORDER SETTING HEARING

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Funding Resource Group and related entities, has filed an application for \$1,535.00 in fees and \$36.18 in expenses for services performed and costs incurred in prosecuting a claim against Mark Talley in the United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee. *Quilling v. Talley*, No. 00-3041-G/BRE. The Receiver also seeks authority to pay his local counsel, Borod & Kramer, \$6,403.25 in attorney's fees and \$24.88 in expenses. The application covers legal fees and expenses incurred in the *Talley* litigation from September 1, 2001 through November 30, 2001 as to the Receiver, and from August 1, 2001 through October 31, 2001 as to the Borod & Kramer firm.

A hearing on the application for fees and expenses is set for <u>January 25, 2002</u> at <u>9:00</u> a.m. in the courtroom of Magistrate Judge Jeff Kaplan, 1100 Commerce Street, 16th Floor, Dallas, Texas. Written objections to the application must be filed by <u>January 11, 2002</u>. Defendants and interested parties will be given an opportunity to present their objections to the application at the hearing.
