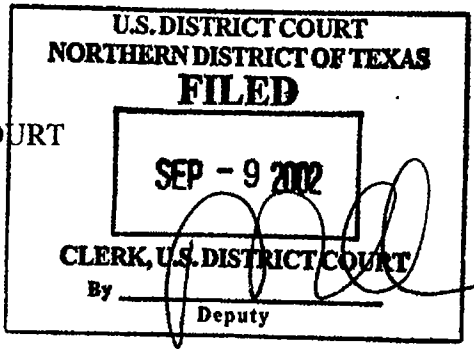

**ORDER SETTING HEARING**

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Funding Resource Group and related entities, has filed an application for \$385.00 in attorney's fees and \$23.60 in expenses for services performed and costs incurred in prosecuting a claim against Mark Talley in the United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee. *Quilling v. Talley*, No. 00-3041-G/BRE. The Receiver also seeks authority to pay his local counsel, Borod & Kramer, \$2,821.25 in attorney's fees and \$14.76 in expenses. The application covers legal fees and expenses incurred in the *Talley* litigation from June 1, 2002 through August 31, 2002 as to the Receiver, and from May 1, 2002 through July 31, 2002 as to Borod & Kramer.


A hearing on the fee application is set for **October 25, 2002** at **9:00 a.m.** in the courtroom of U.S. Magistrate Judge Jeff Kaplan, 1100 Commerce Street, 16th Floor, Dallas, Texas. Written objections to the application must be filed by **October 15, 2002**. Interested parties will be given an opportunity to present their objections to the application at the hearing.
