ORDER SETTING HEARING

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Funding Resource Group and related entities, has filed an application for \$1,441.50 in attorney's fees and \$138.14 in expenses for services performed and costs incurred in prosecuting a counterclaim against National Union Fire Insurance Company in the United States District Court for the District of Arizona. *National Union Fire Ins. Co. v. United States Holdings*, No. CIV 2001-0657-PHX. The Receiver also seeks authority to pay his local counsel, Holden Brodman, PLC, \$10,234.50 in attorney's fees and \$268.58 in expenses. The application covers legal fees and expenses incurred in the *National Union* litigation from June 1, 2002 through August 31, 2002 as to the Receiver, and from May 1, 2002 through July 31, 2002 as to Holden Brodman.

A hearing on the fee application is set for <u>October 25, 2002</u> at <u>9:00 a.m.</u> in the courtroom of U.S. Magistrate Judge Jeff Kaplan, 1100 Commerce Street, 16th Floor, Dallas, Texas. Written objections to the application must be filed by <u>October 15, 2002</u>. Interested parties will be given an opportunity to present their objections to the application at the hearing.
