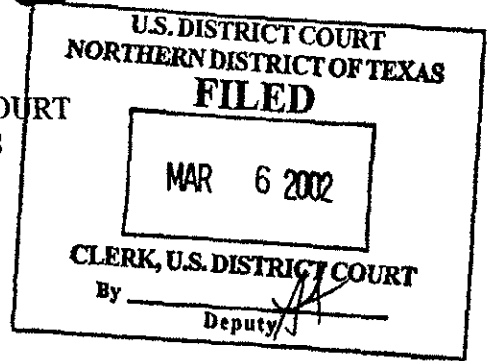

JUDGMENT


For the reasons stated in the Memorandum Opinion and Order dated March 6, 2002, plaintiff's motion for summary judgment is granted. The check and wire transfers from bank accounts held or controlled by B. David Gilliland to Melody Wolcott Gilliland between May 28, 1997 and May 14, 1999, totaling \$266,790, are hereby voided and set aside. This includes bank accounts in the name of Covent Garden, LLC, Tactical Capital Placement, LLC, and Hammersmith Trust, LLC. Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Hammersmith Trust, LLC and related entities, shall have and recover the sum of \$266,790 from Melody Wolcott Gilliland, together with post-judgment interest at the rate of 2.24% per annum until paid.

All costs of court are taxed against Melody Wolcott Gilliland.

The Receiver shall be entitled to all writs, processes, and other remedies allowed by law to collect this judgment.
