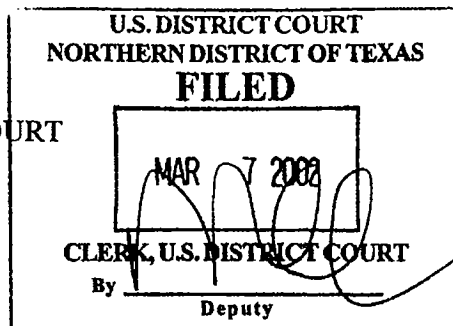

ORDER SETTING HEARING

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Funding Resource Group and related entities, has filed an application for \$13,955.00 in attorney's fees and \$215.14 in expenses for services performed and costs incurred in prosecuting a claim against The Wolcott Lifetime Trust in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Michigan. *Quilling v. The Wolcott Lifetime Trust*, No. 1-00-CV-826. The Receiver also seeks authority to pay his local counsel, Smith Haughey Rice & Roegge, \$399.00 in attorney's fees and \$10.52 in expenses. The application covers legal fees and expenses incurred in *The Wolcott Lifetime Trust* litigation from December 1, 2001 through February 28, 2002 as to the Receiver, and from November 1, 2001 through January 31, 2002 as to the Smith Haughey firm.



Written objections to the application must be filed by **April 9, 2002**. Defendants and interested parties will be given an opportunity to present their objections to the application at the hearing.
