

ORDER SETTING HEARING

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Funding Resource Group and related entities, has filed an application for \$52,125.50 in fees and \$6,032.78 in expenses for services performed and costs incurred in prosecuting a claim against The Wolcott Lifetime Trust in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Michigan. *Quilling v. The Wolcott Lifetime Trust*, No. 1-00-CV-826. The Receiver also seeks authority to pay his local counsel, Smith Haughey Rice & Rogge, \$1,178.00 in attorney's fees and \$29.76 in expenses. The application covers legal services performed and expenses incurred in *The Wolcott Lifetime Trust* litigation from December 1, 2000 through May 31, 2001.

A hearing on the fee application is set for <u>July 13, 2001</u> at <u>9:00 a.m.</u>, in the courtroom of Magistrate Judge Jeff Kaplan, 1100 Commerce Street, 16th Floor, Dallas, Texas. Written objections to the application must be filed by <u>July 2, 2001</u>. Defendants and interested parties will be given an opportunity to present their objections to the application at the hearing.
