## ORDER SETTING HEARING

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Funding Resource Group and related entities, has filed an application for \$1,705.00 in attorney's fees and \$46.25 in expenses for services performed and costs incurred in prosecuting a claim against The Wolcott Lifetime Trust in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Michigan. *Quilling v. The Wolcott Lifetime Trust*, No. 1-00-CIV-826. The Receiver also seeks authority to pay his local counsel, Smith Haughey Rice & Roegge, \$57.00 in attorney's fees. The application covers legal fees and expenses incurred in the *The Wolcott Lifetime Trust* litigation from June 1, 2002 through August 31, 2002 as to the Receiver, and from May 1, 2002 through July 31, 2002 as to the Smith Haughey firm.

A hearing on the fee application is set for <u>October 25, 2002</u> at <u>9:00 a.m.</u>, in the courtroom of U.S. Magistrate Judge Jeff Kaplan, 1100 Commerce Street, 16th Floor, Dallas, Texas. Written objections to the application must be filed by <u>October 15, 2002</u>. Interested parties will be given an opportunity to present their objections to the application at the hearing.
