

ORDER SETTING HEARING

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Funding Resource Group and related entities, has filed an application for \$1,787.50 in attorney's fees and \$48.66 in expenses for services performed and costs incurred in prosecuting a claim against The Wolcott Lifetime Trust in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Michigan. Quilling v. The Wolcott Lifetime Trust, et al., No. 1-00-CV-826. The Receiver also seeks authority to pay his local counsel, Smith Haughey Rice & Roegge, P.C., \$19.00 in attorney's fees. The application covers legal fees and expenses incurred in The Wolcott Lifetime Trust litigation from September 1, 2002 through November 30, 2002 as to the Receiver, and from August 1, 2002 through October 31, 2002 as to Smith Haughey.

A hearing on the fee application is set for <u>January 10, 2003</u> at <u>9:00 a.m.</u>, in the courtroom of U.S. Magistrate Judge Jeff Kaplan, 1100 Commerce Street, 16th Floor, Dallas, Texas. Written objections to the application must be filed by <u>December 31, 2002</u>. Interested parties will be given an opportunity to present their objections to the application at the hearing.
