Gentlemen:

On July 5, 2005, the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas appointed me as Receiver for a number of individuals and entities, including Bradley Stark and Sardaukar Holdings. A copy of the Order is enclosed. Since that time, in my capacity as receiver, I have liquidated various assets relating to Sardaukar Holdings and Bradley Stark. If you invested funds with Sardaukar Holdings and have not been completely repaid, you may have a claim against Sardaukar Holdings.

The Court has approved an Official Claim Form, which must be completed and submitted to the Receiver in order for you to be eligible to participate in a distribution of funds from the monies being held by the Receiver.

You are hereby instructed to complete and return the enclosed Claim Form as soon as possible. You are further advised that Bradley Stark has no authority to pay any funds to you. Instead, the only funds that will be repaid to you will be paid by the Receiver. Please give this matter the attention it deserves and submit the Claim Form as quickly as possible. If you do not complete the Claim Form, I will ask the Court to disallow any claim you may have.
