**ORDER**

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Megafund Corporation and related entities, has filed a fourth motion to allow "A" claims against the Megafund Receivership Estate. As of March 14, 2008, the Receiver has approved three additional claims totaling \$62,200.00.<sup>1</sup> By this motion, the Receiver seeks court approval of those claims and authority to make an interim pro rata distribution of \$11,645.39, which means that each claimant would receive approximately 18.72% of their claim.

The Receiver is ordered to post a copy of his motion, along with the proposed list of approved claims attached thereto as Exhibit "1," and this order on his website, [www.secreceiver.com](http://www.secreceiver.com). Appropriate links to the court's docket shall be provided to users of the website. Any interested party who objects to a proposed allowed claim must file written objections with the court by **April 7, 2008**. Objections should be addressed to:


