



On July 18, 2005, this court issued an order granting Plaintiff's Motion for Extension of Temporary Restraining Order and Continuance of Hearing on Motion for Preliminary Injunction as to Relief Defendant CIG, Ltd., filed July 13, 2005. *See* Order, July 18, 2005 (hereinafter, the "July 18, 2005 Order"). At the time the court issued the July 18, 2005 Order, CIG, Ltd. was a relief-defendant. Thereafter, Plaintiff filed an Amended Complaint naming CIG, Ltd. as a defendant. Concurrently herewith, the court is issuing an order granting Plaintiff's Second Application for *Ex Parte* Temporary Restraining Order, Preliminary Injunction and Other Emergency Relief. *See* Second *Ex Parte* Temporary Restraining Order and Order Freezing Assets and Granting Other Emergency Relief (hereinafter, "Second Restraining Order"). The Second Restraining Order is

issued as against Defendants CIG, Ltd. And James A. Rumpf, individually and doing business as Cilak International. This second retraining order moots the July 18, 2005 Order. Accordingly, the July 18, 2005 Order is hereby **vacated**.
