THIS MATTER IS BEFORE THE COURT with the consent of the parties for the appointment of a receiver. A hearing was held on this matter on October 29, 2001.

With consent of, and stipulation by, the parties, this Court hereby appoints Attorney Michael J. Quilling to serve as the receiver in the above-captioned matter, pursuant to the terms and requirements of the consent order dated October 11, 2001 (doc. 23).

The parties agree that Attorney Quilling has produced for the Court sufficient information to satisfy the Court that he does not have a conflict of interest arising out of any prior receivership.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Mr. Quilling is appointed receiver, effective immediately.

Further, this Court has previously granted a consent motion for joinder of persons needed for just adjudication under Rule 19 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure (docs. 23, 24). Pursuant to Rule 19(b), Mr. Quilling is deemed to be the representative of the claimants who are required to be joined. As to any claimant, service upon Mr. Quilling combined with notice by Mr. Quilling to a claimant shall suffice as service on that claimant for purposes
