ORDER EXPANDING RECEIVER'S POWERS AND DUTIES


On this day came on for consideration the Receiver's Unopposed Application to Expand Powers and Duties. The Court, being familiar with the pleadings and papers on file herein, and having considered the unopposed nature of the Application was of the opinion, and so found, the Application should be granted. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED, that the Receiver, Michael J. Quilling, is hereby authorized to undertake the following actions with respect to a Motion for Return of Property Seized filed by MM APMC Banque De Commerce, Inc. in Cause No. 3:98mc96-McK;

- a. the right to respond to the Motion and be heard at the time of any hearing;
- b. the right to conduct discovery and issue subpoenas with respect to the Motion;
- c. the right to take such other and further action as is necessary to protect the interests of the other potential claimants to the funds; and

- d. the right to take such actions with respect to the alleged Escrow Agreement as are necessary to protect the interests of other claimants, including without limitation, the right to terminate the Agreement.
